BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 26-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) Any member of a board or commission whose term has 4 expired and who is not disqualified for membership under 5 subsection (a) may continue in office as a holdover member until 6 a successor is nominated and appointed; provided that a holdover 7 member shall not hold office beyond the end of the second 8 regular legislative session following the expiration of the member's term of office. This subsection shall take precedence 9 10 over all conflicting statutes concerning holdover members." 11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
