A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the legislature
- 2 passed House Bill No. 1600, H.D. 1, S.D. 2, C.D. 1, Regular
- 3 Session of 2022, which appropriated funds received by the State
- 4 from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, P.L. 117-2,
- 5 section 9901, to the department of business, economic
- 6 development, and tourism under BED-100 for its building
- 7 renovations in the amount of \$660,000 for fiscal year 2022-2023.
- 8 However, the governor line-item vetoed that amount among other
- 9 items on July 6, 2022, before enacting the remainder of the bill
- 10 as Act 248, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, on July 7, 2022, mainly
- 11 to comply with the federally mandated Elementary and Secondary
- 12 School Emergency Relief Funds' Maintenance of Effort
- 13 requirement.
- 14 Due to health and safety concerns and deteriorating
- 15 conditions, the entire fifth floor of the No. 1 Capitol District
- 16 Building, located at 250 South Hotel Street, Honolulu, Hawaii,

- 1 needs to be completely gutted. The department of business,
- 2 economic development, and tourism currently occupies the fifth
- 3 floor of the building. The department of accounting and general
- 4 services will be undertaking the renovation.
- 5 The department of business, economic development, and
- 6 tourism, however, will be required to pay for expenses related
- 7 to the building renovations, which are not included in the
- 8 department of accounting and general services' solicitation for
- 9 bid of improvements to the building infrastructure.
- 10 Decluttering, moving and storage of items, and replacement of
- 11 the partitions are not covered under the department of
- 12 accounting and general services' solicitation for bid.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate general funds to
- 14 the department of business, economic development, and tourism
- 15 for expenses related to the building renovations of its offices
- 16 on the fifth floor of the No. 1 Capitol District Building,
- 17 located at 250 South Hotel Street, Honolulu, Hawaii.
- 18 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 20 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 to
- 21 cover the expenses related to the building renovations of the

- 1 offices of the department of business, economic development, and
- 2 tourism.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 4 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
- 5 this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 6, 2050.
