A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRUCK BEDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 291-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended as follows: 3 1. By amending subsection (a) to read: 4 "(a) No person shall stand in the bed or load-carrying 5 area of any motor vehicle commonly known as a pickup truck while 6 the vehicle is in operation. No operator of any pickup truck shall operate the vehicle with a passenger seated in the bed or 7 8 load-carrying area of the vehicle [unless: 9 (1) There is no seating available in the cab of the 10 vehicle; (2) The side racks of the vehicle are securely attached 11 12 and the tailboard or tailgate is securely closed; 13 (3) Every passenger in the bed or load carrying area of the vehicle is seated on the floor and does not 14 15 attempt to control unlashed cargo.]
- 16 except as allowed under subsection (c)."
- 17 2. By amending subsections (c) and (d) to read:

- 1 "(c) No operator of any pickup truck may operate the
- 2 vehicle with any passenger [twelve years of age or under] in the
- 3 bed or load-carrying area of the vehicle, unless one of the
- 4 following applies:
- 5 (1) An emergency exists that threatens the life of the
- 6 passenger being transported in the bed or load-
- 7 carrying area of the vehicle; or
- **8** (2) The vehicle is being operated in parades, caravans, or
- 9 exhibitions [which] that are officially authorized or
- otherwise permitted by law.
- 11 (d) Any person who violates this section shall be subject
- 12 to a fine of \$25 for each violation[, provided that any person
- 13 who violates subsection (c) shall be subject to a fine of \$50
- 14 for each separate-violation]."
- 15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Pickup Trucks; Passengers in Load-carrying Area or Beds

Prohibits operation of a pickup truck with any passengers seated in the bed or load-carrying area unless in an emergency or an officially authorized parade caravan, or exhibition. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
