BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§304A- Annual report; employees working outside of the
5	State. Beginning December 31, 2023, and each December 31
6	thereafter, the university shall submit an annual report to the
7	legislature of all university employees who performed work from
8	a location outside of the State during the applicable year. The
9	report shall include, for each employee who performed work from
10	a location outside of the State, the position; position
11	description; salary range; and number of days, weeks, or years
12	spent performing work from a location outside of the State."
13	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
