20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
3 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act, as
4 follows:

- 5 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 and 2 shall be
6 expended by the department of land and natural
7 resources; and
8 (2) The sums appropriated in item 3 shall be expended by
9 the department of education.
