A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FOURTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$18,805,000 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
- 4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024
- 5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
- 6 fourteenth senatorial district, as follows:
- 7 1. Kalihi Uka elementary school
- 8 A. Plans, design, equipment, and
- 9 construction to stabilize the
- foundation in buildings A and C,
- 11 stabilize walkways in building C,
- 12 and surround the school with a
- 13 six-foot perimeter fence for
- safety.
