A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE FIRST RESPONDERS TECHNOLOGY CAMPUS AND CYBERSECURITY DATA CENTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that critical
- 2 infrastructure for state and county first responders and data
- 3 systems needs to be relocated. Many existing facilities are
- 4 outdated and within the inundation zone, and agencies have
- 5 outgrown their current footprint. Some agencies lack permanent
- 6 headquarters, training facilities, and storage space and require
- 7 the use of leased facilities, which should be invested in
- 8 permanent assets that are owned and controlled by the State.
- 9 The legislature further finds that lands purchased by the
- 10 Hawaii technology development corporation are dedicated for the
- 11 first responders technology campus and cybersecurity data
- 12 center. The first responders technology campus is a major
- 13 project involving federal, state, and county first responders
- 14 and the office of enterprise technology services to co-locate
- 15 headquarters and training facilities in central Oahu. Being
- 16 outside of the inundation zone, this new facility would provide

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- 1 critical partnerships for the State's first responders as they
- 2 coordinate joint trainings and responses. The site is also near
- 3 the only airfield outside of the inundation zone, as Hickam Air
- 4 Force Base, Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, and Kalaeloa
- 5 Airport are near the shorelines. Moving and co-locating
- 6 critical infrastructure outside of the inundation zone will
- 7 provide a strategy for shoreline retreat and accommodation.
- 8 The legislature further finds that the Hawaii emergency
- 9 management agency, Hawaii army national guard, department of
- 10 land and natural resources, department of public safety, and
- 11 department of law enforcement have committed to coordinate
- 12 access to the first responders technology campus and
- 13 cybersecurity data center with federal agencies also expressing
- 14 interest in the project.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
- 16 development of the first responders technology campus and
- 17 cybersecurity data center on tax map key 9-5-002-057.
- 18 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,000,000 or so
- 20 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
- 21 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal

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- 1 year 2024-2025 for the development of the first responders
- 2 technology campus and cybersecurity data center on tax map key
- **3** 9-5-002-057.
- 4 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 5 technology development corporation for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this Act shall not
- 7 lapse at the end of the fiscal biennium for which the
- 8 appropriations are made; provided that all moneys from the
- 9 appropriations that are unencumbered as of June 30, 2025, shall
- 10 lapse as of that date.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
