# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE PARKS SPECIAL FUND.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 184-3.4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3           "(b) The department shall expend the moneys from the state  
4 parks special fund for the following purposes:

5           (1) Permanent and temporary staff positions;

6           (2) Planning and development of state parks programs,  
7 including the aina hoomalu state parks program;

8           (3) Construction, repairs, replacement, additions, and  
9 extensions of state parks facilities;

10          (4) Operation and maintenance costs of state parks and  
11 state parks programs; [and]

12          (5) Any departmental program aimed at environmental  
13 protection; and

14          [+5] (6) Administrative costs of the division of state  
15 parks."

16          SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.


