A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TORT LIABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the liability
- 2 protections afforded to lifeguards in Act 170, Session Laws of
- 3 Hawaii 2002, were repealed on June 30, 2017. Act 170 provided
- 4 liability protection for lifequard services on the beach or in
- 5 the ocean, except for gross negligence or wanton acts or
- 6 omissions. This limited liability protection was made necessary
- 7 because some counties would not provide lifequard services at
- 8 state beach parks due to the fear of potential liability. The
- $oldsymbol{9}$ legislature finds that Act 170 created a climate in which
- 10 lifeguard services could be provided by the counties without
- 11 fear of liability, and therefore is a life-saving measure that
- 12 should be reestablished.
- 13 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to permanently
- 14 reinstate the liability protections previously afforded for
- 15 lifeguard services.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately 2 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 Exception to liability for county lifeguard **services**. (a) For the purposes of this section: 5 6 "County lifeguard" means a person employed as a lifeguard 7 by a county of this State. 8 "Employing_county" means the county employing a county 9 lifeguard. 10 (b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, neither 11 a county lifeguard, the employing county, nor the State shall be 12 liable for any civil damages resulting from any act or omission 13 of the lifeguard while providing rescue, resuscitative, or other 14 lifeguard services on the beach or in the ocean in the scope of employment as a county lifeguard; provided that this exception 15 16 from liability shall not apply when the claim for civil damages 17 arises from a county lifeguard's alleged gross negligence or 18 wanton act or omission." 19 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
