BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require that the
2	person or organization that filed an ethics charge to the
3	commission be informed of the status of the charge upon request,
4	including the final disposition.
5	SECTION 2. Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
6	by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately
7	designated and to read as follows:
8	" <u>§84-</u> Charge filed by a person or organization other
9	than the commission. If a charge concerning alleged violations
10	of this chapter is filed by a person or organization other than
11	the commission, the person or organization that has filed a
12	charge with the commission shall be informed of the status of
13	the charge upon request, including the final disposition of the
14	charge, whether by order to dismiss, issuance of an informal
15	advisory opinion, decision after a hearing, or final disposition
16	
	by any other means."
