A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSPECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 321-1.9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[f]§321-1.9[f] Inspections; visits; state-licensed or state-certified care facilities. (a) The department of health shall conduct unannounced visits and inspections, including 5 inspections for relicensing or recertification, for the 6 7 following state-licensed or state-certified care facilities on an annual basis and at such intervals as determined by the 8 9 department to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of each 10 resident: 11 (1)Adult day health centers; Adult day care centers; 12 (2) 13 (3) Community care foster family homes; Developmental disabilities domiciliary homes; 14 (4)15 (5) Adult foster homes; 16 (6) Long-term care facilities, including but not limited 17 to:

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1	(A)	Adult residential care nomes;	
2	(B)	Expanded adult residential care homes;	
3	(C)	Assisted living facilities;	
4	(D)	Intermediate care facilities;	
5	(E)	Nursing facilities; and

13	hours. Annual	inspections for relicensing or recertification	
14	may be conducte	ed during regular business hours or at intervals	
15	determined by t	the department. Annual inspections for	
16	relicensing or	recertification shall be conducted without	
17	notice. <u>Inspec</u>	ctions for relicensing of all adult residential	
18	care homes, con	mmunity care foster family homes, developmental	
19	disabilities do	omiciliary homes, and expanded adult residential	
20	care homes shall	ll be scheduled at a date and time agreeable to

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1	(c) Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (b) to the		
2	contrary, the department of health shall limit unannounced		
3	inspections to investigate complaints pertaining to client or		
4	patient abuse or life- or health-threatening danger at adult		
5	residential care homes for five or less residents, community		
6	care foster family homes, developmental disabilities domiciliary		
7	homes, and expanded adult residential care homes. Complainants		
8	shall be required to identify themselves, make their complaint		
9	in writing, and have a credible basis upon which to make the		
10	complaint, such as an eyewitness account, for the complaint to		
11	be actionable by the department of health or department of human		
12	services or its designated inspection contractors.		
13	$[\frac{(c)}{(c)}]$ (d) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to		
14	chapter 91 to effectuate the purposes of this section."		
15	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
16	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

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Report Title:

State-Licensed or State-Certified Care Facilities; Inspections; Limitation; Complaints; Department of Health

Description:

Requires the Department of Health to limit unannounced inspections to investigate complaints pertaining to client or patient abuse or life- or health-threatening danger at certain state-licensed or state-certified care facilities and establishes requirements to file complaints against the care facilities. Requires relicensing inspections of certain care facilities to be scheduled.

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
