A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ABANDONED VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 290, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "S290- Fees and fines; waiver. The directors of
- 5 finance of each county may waive, for a period not to exceed one
- 6 year after the subject charge, fee, or fine becomes due and
- 7 payable, payment of any outstanding tow, storage, or other
- 8 charge, fee, or fine owed to the county in accordance with this
- 9 chapter; provided that this section shall not apply to any tow,
- 10 storage, or other charge, fee, or fine incurred for a vehicle
- 11 deemed to be a derelict vehicle pursuant to section 290-8."
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 14 begun before its effective date.
- 15 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
