A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CAMPAIGN SPENDING COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the campaign
- 2 spending commission, the state agency for enforcement of our
- 3 campaign finance laws, does not have a designated investigator
- 4 position. The existing five staff members perform investigative
- 5 duties, as needed, including testifying in court when cases are
- 6 prosecuted. The legislature further finds that in order to
- 7 maintain the integrity and transparency of the campaign finance
- 8 process, increasing the commission staff by one investigator
- 9 position is necessary.
- 10 The purpose of this act is to establish an investigator
- 11 position in the campaign spending commission.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$125,000 or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
- 15 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 16 2024-2025 for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) permanent

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- 1 investigator position to be placed in the campaign spending
- 2 commission.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the campaign
- 4 spending commission for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
