## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE RENTAL HOUSING REVOLVING FUND.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 201H-86, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
  amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:

  "(f) [#] For loans made prior to July 1, 2024, if the
- 4 owner is not in default, the corporation may forgive the amount
- 5 remaining under [ $\frac{1}{2}$ ]  $\underline{a}$  no-interest loan to the owner of [ $\frac{1}{2}$ ]  $\underline{a}$
- $\mathbf{6}$  qualified low-income building <u>under this section</u> after thirty
- 7 years."
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 201H-202, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
- $^{"}(d)$  The fund shall be used to provide loans or grants for
- 11 the development, pre-development, construction, acquisition,
- 12 preservation, and substantial rehabilitation of rental housing
- 13 units. The corporation shall not forgive any loan made from the
- 14 <u>fund.</u> Permitted uses of the fund may include but are not
- 15 limited to planning, design, land acquisition, costs of options,
- 16 agreements of sale, downpayments, equity financing, capacity
- 17 building of nonprofit housing developers, or other housing

- 1 development services or activities as provided in rules adopted
- 2 by the corporation pursuant to chapter 91. The rules may
- 3 provide for a means of recapturing loans or grants made from the
- 4 fund if a rental housing project financed under the fund is
- 5 refinanced or sold at a later date. The rules may also provide
- 6 that moneys from the fund shall be leveraged with other
- 7 financial resources to the extent possible."
- 8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
