## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIMITING A CAMPAIGN'S ACCEPTANCE OF CASH CONTRIBUTIONS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-351, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) A candidate, candidate committee, or noncandidate
- 4 committee, shall not accept a contribution of more than \$100 in
- 5 cash, in the aggregate, from a single person [without issuing]
- $\mathbf{6}$  during each election period and shall issue a receipt to the
- 7 contributor and  $[\frac{keeping}]$   $\underline{keep}$  a record of the contribution."
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 9 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 10 begun before its effective date.
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
