A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii is the only
state without a fire marshal's office. In 1978, the office of
the state fire marshal was abolished and its functions and
responsibilities relating to the protection of persons and
property against fire loss with the respective county
governments was transferred to the counties through Act 241,
Session Laws of Hawaii 1978.

8 The legislature further finds that the state fire marshal 9 would serve as an integral role in coordinating fire prevention 10 between local agencies. The legislature recognizes that the 11 state fire council currently does not have the funding and staff 12 to perform the duties of a state fire marshal. The legislature 13 further recognizes that reestablishing the position of the state fire marshal would fill gaps in state and local enforcement, 14 15 provide leadership in fire and arson investigations, and ensure 16 wildfire risk is mitigated as much as possible.

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1 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to re-establish the 2 position of the state fire marshal. 3 SECTION 2. Chapter 132, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 5 and to read as follows: 6 "§353C- State fire marshal; establishment; appointment; 7 powers; duties; police powers; responsibilities. (a) There is 8 established within the department of law enforcement, a division 9 of the state fire marshal, that shall be administered by a state 10 fire marshal, who shall be appointed by the director, after a 11 referral and mutual agreement between the director and the state 12 fire council. The appointment of the state fire marshal shall 13 be made without regard to chapters 76 and 89, and shall not be 14 subject to the advice and consent of the senate. In the event 15 of a vacancy, the state fire council and the director shall meet 16 expeditiously to select and appoint a new state fire marshal. 17 To facilitate the appointment of the state fire marshal, the 18 director shall establish the terms of employment for the 19 position of state fire marshal. 20 The state fire marshal shall have the same powers and (b)

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SECTION 4. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of 1 2 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, 3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, 4 and this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure 5 ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by 6 7 per cent. This current declaration takes Ŝ or into account general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal 8 9 year 2024-2025 in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, and this Act only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure 10 ceiling are that: 11 12 The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to (1) serve the public interest; and 13 14 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs 15 addressed by this Act. SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 17 or so 18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for 19 the following:

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1 for the establishment of one full-time (1) \$ 2 equivalent (1.00 FTE) permanent state fire marshal 3 position; (2) \$ for the establishment of one full-time 4 equivalent (1.00 FTE) permanent position to support 5 the state fire marshal; and 6 7 (3) \$ for training, office supplies, rent, and other operating and administrative costs to support 8 9 the state fire marshal, 10 in carrying out the purposes of this Act. 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Department 12 of Law Enforcement for the purposes of this Act. 13 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 15 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
