RELATING TO CORRECTIONS.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- $\hat{f 1}$ SECTION 1. The legislature finds that prison pet programs
- 2 started in the 1980s as a way to decrease recidivism. Several
- 3 states, including California and Indiana, have implemented
- 4 programs that allow inmates to foster animals while
- 5 incarcerated. Research shows that pet programs improve personal
- $\hat{\mathbf{6}}$ responsibility for inmates; relationships between inmates,
- 7 prison staff, and administrators; and inmates' self-esteem,
- 8 self-efficacy, and empathy. Pet programs have also been shown
- 9 to increase emotional intelligence, coping skills, work ethic,
- $10\,$ and employability, which improve the chances of job readiness
- 11 and are critical factors in reducing recidivism. Pet programs
- 12 also help to address staffing problems in animal shelters by
- 13 having inmates care for animals and prepare them for adoption.
