A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WORLD PEACE DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that World Peace Day,
- 2 also officially known as the International Day of Peace, is a
- 3 United Nations-sanctioned holiday observed around the world on
- 4 the twenty-first day of September. Originally established in
- 5 1981 by the United Nations General Assembly, the holiday is
- 6 dedicated to world peace through observing twenty-four hours of
- 7 non-violence and cease-fire.
- 8 The legislature further finds that as international
- 9 conflict continues in certain parts of the world, the
- 10 recognition and aspiration toward world peace becomes more
- 11 important and significant.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to designate World Peace Day as
- 13 a state holiday in substitution of the existing Good Friday
- 14 holiday.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 8-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
