A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

8	capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
9	expended for the purpose of this Act by the department of
10	education.
11	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
