
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADVISORY BOARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 163D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§163D- Advisory board; workforce development. (a)

5 There shall be established an advisory board to the corporation.

6 The advisory board shall focus on workforce development for the
7 agricultural industry.

8 (b) The advisory board shall consist of the following
9 members:

10 (1) The director of labor and industrial relations, or the
11 director's designee;

12 (2) The superintendent of education, or the
13 superintendent's designee;

14 (3) The vice president for community colleges for the
15 university of Hawaii, or the vice president's
16 designee;



1 (4) A representative of a non-profit organization founded
2 by Hawaii farmers and ranchers that works with
3 organizations, communities, and individuals involved
4 in the agricultural industry in Hawaii, or the
5 representative's designee, who shall be invited by the
6 governor to participate; and

7 (5) Three individuals with appropriate experience, who
8 shall be appointed by the governor, and whose terms
9 shall end at the end of each gubernatorial term;
10 provided that the governor may reappoint any member
11 serving pursuant to this paragraph; provided further
12 that nongovernmental members shall be invited by the
13 governor to participate.

14 (c) The advisory board shall meet as often as practicable,
15 but no less than once per _____.

16 (d) The appointed members of the advisory board shall
17 serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses,
18 including travel expenses, necessary for the performance of
19 their duties."



1 SECTION 2. Chapter 206M, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§206M- Advisory board; workforce development. (a)

5 There shall be established an advisory board to the development
6 corporation. The advisory board shall focus on workforce
7 development for the technology industry.

8 (b) The advisory board shall consist of the following
9 members:

10 (1) The director of labor and industrial relations, or the
11 director's designee;

12 (2) The superintendent of education, or the
13 superintendent's designee;

14 (3) The vice president for community colleges for the
15 university of Hawaii, or the vice president's
16 designee; and

17 (4) Three individuals with appropriate experience, who
18 shall be appointed by the governor, and whose terms
19 shall end at the end of each gubernatorial term;
20 provided that the governor may reappoint any member
21 serving pursuant to this paragraph; provided further



1 that nongovernmental members shall be invited by the
2 governor to participate.

3 (c) The advisory board shall meet as often as practicable,
4 but no less than once per .

5 (d) The appointed members of the advisory board shall
6 serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses,
7 including travel expenses, necessary for the performance of
8 their duties."

9 SECTION 3. Chapter 227D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
11 and to read as follows:

12 "§227D- **Advisory board; workforce development.** (a)

13 There shall be established an advisory board to the authority.
14 The advisory board shall focus on workforce development for the
15 natural energy industry.

16 (b) The advisory board shall consist of the following
17 members:

18 (1) The director of labor and industrial relations, or the
19 director's designee;

20 (2) The superintendent of education, or the
21 superintendent's designee;



1 (3) The vice president for community colleges for the
2 university of Hawaii, or the vice president's
3 designee; and

4 (4) Three individuals with appropriate experience, who
5 shall be appointed by the governor, and whose terms
6 shall end at the end of each gubernatorial term;
7 provided that the governor may reappoint any member
8 serving pursuant to this paragraph; provided further
9 that nongovernmental members shall be invited by the
10 governor to participate.

11 (c) The advisory board shall meet as often as practicable,
12 but no less than once per _____.

13 (d) The appointed members of the advisory board shall
14 serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses,
15 including travel expenses, necessary for the performance of
16 their duties."

17 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
