## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPEEDING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 291C-104, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
3	"(c) Any person who violates this section shall be fined
4	$$250[_{7}]_{\underline{;}}$ may be charged with a surcharge of up to \$100 to be
5	deposited into the trauma system special fund[ $_{7}$ ]; and, where the
6	violation involves speeding in a school zone, shall be charged
7	with a surcharge of \$25 to be deposited into the safe routes to
8	school program special fund[ $\div$ ] and may be subject to the
9	following:
10	(1) For the first offense, an additional fine of \$250;
11	(2) For the second offense, an additional fine of \$500;
12	and
13	(3) For the third or subsequent offense occurring within
14	eighteen months of a first offense:
15	(A) An additional fine of \$1000; and
16	(B) Revocation of license and privilege to operate a
17	vehicle for a period of one year."

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
