A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CESSPOOL CONVERSIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 153, Session Laws		
2	of Hawaii 2022, established a cesspool compliance pilot grant		
3	project to assist property owners, including lessees on Hawaii		
4	home lands, with upgrading, converting, or connecting a		
5	cesspool. The pilot grant project is set to sunset in 2028.		
6	The purpose of this Act is to:		
7	(1) Require the department of health to submit a report to		
8	the legislature on the cesspool compliance pilot grant		
9	project prior to the regular session of 2025;		
10	(2) Establish and appropriate moneys for three full-time		
11	equivalent (3.0 FTE) positions within the cesspool		
12	compliance pilot grant project; and		
13	(3) Appropriate funds for the cesspool compliance pilot		
14	grant project for fiscal year 2024-2025.		
15	SECTION 2. Act 153, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, is		
16	amended by amending section 2 as follows:

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1	"(b)	The department of health shall not grant awards to	
2	any owner	of real property with a cesspool or lessee on Hawaiian

6		[2021] <u>2022</u> Hawaii cesspool [hazard assessment and]	
7		prioritization tool;	
8	(2)	The owner or lessee provides the department with the

12		the department of health."

6 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of 7 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, 8 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the 9 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, 10 and this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure 11 ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by

12 \$ or per cent. This current declaration takes 13 into account general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal 14 year 2024-2025 in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, and this Act 15 only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure 16 ceiling are that:

- 17 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to18 serve the public interest; and
- 19 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs20 addressed by this Act.

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1 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$249,000 or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the 4 establishment of three full-time equivalent (3.0 FTE) permanent 5 positions comprising one engineer V position, one engineer IV 6 position, and one accountant IV position within the cesspool 7 compliance pilot grant project established by Act 153, Session 8 Laws of Hawaii 2022.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of10 health for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$5,249,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the cesspool compliance pilot grant project established by Act 153, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 17 health for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

20 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
