## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2024.
- 3 SECTION 2. Act 70, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023, is amended
- 4 by amending part II to read as follows:
- 5 "PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS
- 6 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
- 7 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
- 8 herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of
- 9 funding specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium
- 10 beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025. The total
- 11 expenditures and the number of permanent and temporary positions
- 12 established in each fiscal year of the fiscal biennium shall not
- 13 exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each
- 14 year, except as provided in this Act.

- 9 inflation."
- 10 SECTION 4. Act 70, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023, is amended
- 11 by amending part IV to read as follows:
- 12 "PART IV. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS
- 13 SECTION 8. The sum of [\$20,955,000] \$37,955,000
- 14 appropriated or authorized in part II of this Act for capital
- 15 improvement projects shall be expended by the judiciary for the
- 16 projects listed below; provided that several related or similar
- 17 projects may be combined into a single project, if a combination
- 18 is advantageous or convenient for implementation; provided
- 19 further that the total cost of the projects thus combined shall
- 20 not exceed the total of the sums specified for the projects
- 21 separately. The amount after each cost element and the total

- 1 funding for each project listed in this part are in thousands of
- 2 dollars.

General obligation bonds may be issued, as 5 provided by law, to yield the amount that may be necessary to finance projects authorized in part II and listed in part IV of 6 7 this Act; provided that the sum total of the general obligation 8 bonds so issued shall not exceed [\$17,955,000.] \$31,955,000." 9 SECTION 6. Act 38, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, as amended by Acts 5 and 9, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020, is amended by 10 11 amending section 7.1 to read as follows: 12 "SECTION 7.1. [(a) Beginning on the effective date of 13 this Act the judiciary shall submit a weekly report to the 14 legislature that includes the following information for all 15 inmates released pursuant to supreme court orders entered in 16 SCPW-20-0000200 and SCPW-20-0000213: 17 (1) The inmate's name; 18 (2) The inmate's release date; 19 (3) The correctional center or facility where the inmate 20 was released from;

         SECTION 7. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of

    the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
20
    37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
21
    that the appropriations contained in this Act will cause the
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- 1 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025
- 2 to be exceeded by \$ , or per cent. The reasons
- 3 for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the
- 4 appropriations made in this Act are necessary to serve the
- 5 public interest and to meet the needs provided for by this Act.
- 6 SECTION 8. If any portion of this Act or its application
- 7 to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid for any
- 8 reason, the remainder of the Act and any provision thereof shall
- 9 not be affected. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
- 10 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
- 11 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to
- 12 fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the
- 13 extent possible.
- 14 SECTION 9. If any manifest clerical, typographical, or
- 15 other mechanical error is found in this Act, the chief justice
- 16 may correct the error. All changes made pursuant to this
- 17 section shall be reported to the legislature at its next regular
- 18 session.
- 19 SECTION 10. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 21 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
