## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BURIAL SITES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is necessary to
- 2 clarify the definition of "burial site" in section 6E-2, Hawaii
- 3 Revised Statutes, as its current definition results in
- 4 questionable interpretations involving multiple burials,
- 5 secondary burials, marked burials, associated burial goods, and
- 6 the immediate surrounding archaeological context of burials.
- 7 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to clarify the
- 8 definition of "burial site" to address the problematic aspect of
- 9 the current definition.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by amending the definition of "burial site" to read as
- 12 follows:
- ""Burial site" means any specific marked or unmarked
- 14 location where prehistoric or historic human skeletal remains
- 15 [and their associated burial goods] of an individual or set of
- 16 individuals are [interred,] found, and [its immediate] the
- 17 surrounding [archaeological] cultural context, including



- 1 associated burial goods that may be present, deemed a unique
- 2 class of historic property and not otherwise included in section
- **3** 6E-41."
- 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
