A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature has received complaints that
- 2 the residents living in the Pacific Palisades area are unable to
- 3 hear the emergency siren located at Pearl City high school, and
- 4 the emergency siren at Palisades elementary school has been
- 5 inoperative for several years. The legislature finds that a new
- 6 emergency siren is needed in the area so that residents can be
- 7 alerted to all civil defense emergencies in a timely manner in
- 8 order to take any necessary safety measures.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
- 10 installation of a new outdoor emergency siren in the Pacific
- 11 Palisades area.
- 12 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 13 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 14 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 15 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023,
- 16 and this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure
- 17 ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by

- 1 \$ or per cent. The current declaration takes
- 2 into account general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal
- 3 year 2024-2025 in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023. The reasons
- 4 for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that:
- 5 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
- 6 serve the public interest; and
- 7 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
- 8 addressed by this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
- 12 the installation of a new outdoor emergency siren in the Pacific
- 13 Palisades area of Oahu in connection with the statewide outdoor
- 14 siren warning system.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 16 defense for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2042.
