A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII FARM TO FOOD BANK PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish and
- 2 appropriate funds for the Hawaii farm to food bank program to
- 3 fund food banks and emergency feeding organizations in the State
- 4 to purchase, store, and transport fresh locally grown or
- 5 produced food to food insecure communities. This program will
- 6 serve the State's food needs, provide local food producers with
- 7 a market to support their operations, and keep moneys
- $oldsymbol{8}$ circulating within the State to boost the local economy.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 "PART . HAWAII FARM TO FOOD BANK PROGRAM
- 13 §141-A Definitions. For the purposes of this part:
- "Department" means the department of agriculture.
- "Food bank" has the same meaning as in title 7 United
- **16** States Code section 7501(5).

- 1 "Fresh locally grown or produced food" means fruits,
- 2 vegetables, nuts, coffee, eggs, poultry and poultry products,
- 3 livestock products, milk and milk products, aquacultural and
- 4 maricultural products, and horticultural products that are one
- 5 hundred per cent grown, raised, and harvested in Hawaii.
- 6 §141-B Hawaii farm to food bank program. (a) There is
- 7 established the Hawaii farm to food bank program to be
- 8 administered by the department. Under the program, the
- 9 department shall relieve food shortages by providing funds to
- 10 food banks and emergency feeding organizations located in the
- 11 State to facilitate consistent supply chains of fresh locally
- 12 grown or produced food that is culturally relevant to food
- 13 insecure communities.
- 14 (b) Food banks and emergency feeding organizations that
- 15 receive support pursuant to this section shall use the funds to
- 16 purchase, store, and transport fresh locally grown or produced
- 17 food in the State that is culturally relevant to recipients at
- 18 no cost to the recipients.
- 19 §141-C Hawaii food assistance program special fund. (a)
- 20 There is established in the state treasury the Hawaii food

- 1 assistance program special fund, into which shall be deposited
- 2 the following:
- 3 (1) Appropriations made by the legislature to the special
- 4 fund;
- 5 (2) Gifts, donations, and grants from public agencies and
- 6 private persons; and
- 7 (3) Interest accrued from moneys in the special fund.
- 8 (b) Expenditures from the Hawaii food assistance program
- 9 special fund shall be authorized and administered by the
- 10 department for the purposes of the Hawaii farm to food bank
- 11 program established pursuant to section 141-B.
- 12 §141-D Rules. The department shall adopt rules pursuant
- 13 to chapter 91 necessary for the purposes of this part."
- 14 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 15 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 16 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 17 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state
- 18 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be
- 19 exceeded by \$ or per cent. In addition, the
- 20 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund
- 21 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further

- 1 exceeded by \$5,000,000 or per cent. The combined total
- 2 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these
- 3 two Acts will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling
- 4 for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by
- 5 \$ or per cent. The reasons for exceeding the
- 6 general fund expenditure ceiling are that:
- 7 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
- 8 serve the public interest; and
- 9 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
- addressed by this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$5,000,000 or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be
- 14 deposited into the Hawaii food assistance program special fund
- 15 established pursuant to section 141-C, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 16 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii food
- 17 assistance program special fund the sum of \$5,000,000 or so much
- 18 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for uses
- 19 consistent with the purposes of the Hawaii food assistance
- 20 program special fund established pursuant to section 141-C,
- 21 Hawaii Revised Statutes.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 6. In codifying the new sections added by section
- 4 2 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
- 5 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
- 6 the new sections in this Act.
- 7 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
