BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 712-1248, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: 3 A person commits the offense of promoting a "(1) detrimental drug in the second degree if the person knowingly: 4 Possesses fifty or more capsules or tablets containing 5 (a) 6 one or more of the Schedule V substances; 7 (b) Possesses one or more preparations, compounds, mixtures, or substances, of an aggregate weight of 8 9 one- eighth ounce or more, containing one or more of the Schedule V substances; 10 Possesses one or more preparations, compounds, 11 (c) 12 mixtures, or substances, of an aggregate weight of 13 [one ounce or] more[7] than two ounces, containing any 14 marijuana; or 15 Distributes any marijuana or any Schedule V substance (d) 16 in any amount."

(1) A person commits the offense of promoting a 4 detrimental drug in the third degree if the person knowingly 5 possesses [any marijuana or] any Schedule V substance in any 6 7 amount. (2) Promoting a detrimental drug in the third degree is a 8 9 petty misdemeanor; provided that possession of [three grams] one 10 ounce or less of marijuana is a violation, punishable by a fine
