A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is a matter of
- 2 statewide concern that the president of the University of Hawaii
- 3 serves simultaneously as the chancellor of the University of
- 4 Hawaii at Manoa. Serving in both roles leads to inevitable
- 5 conflicts of interest. Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is
- 6 to prohibit a person from concurrently serving as the president
- 7 of the University of Hawaii and as chancellor of any University
- 8 of Hawaii campus.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by adding a new section to part I, subpart A, to be
- 11 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 12 "§304A- President of the University of Hawaii;
- 13 prohibition on concurrent service. No person shall serve
- 14 concurrently as president of the University of Hawaii and as
- 15 chancellor of any University of Hawaii campus, including as an
- 16 acting or interim chancellor."
- 17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
