A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE GENERATION OF WILDFIRE SUSCEPTIBILITY MAPS FOR HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the establishment of
- 2 a two-year program to generate web-GIS wildfire susceptibility
- 3 and vulnerability maps for the State is a matter of statewide
- 4 concern pursuant to article X, section 6, of the Hawaii State
- 5 Constitution.
- 6 SECTION 2. (a) The university of Hawaii shall establish
- 7 and implement a two-year program to generate web-GIS wildfire
- 8 susceptibility and vulnerability maps for the State to determine
- 9 which communities, landscapes, buildings, and infrastructure are
- 10 most vulnerable to future wildfires.
- 11 (b) The university of Hawaii shall submit a report of its
- 12 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 13 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 14 to the convening of the regular session of 2026.
- 15 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of
- 16 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and

- 1 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
- 2 that the appropriation contained in this Act will cause the
- 3 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025
- 4 to be exceeded by \$ or per cent. The reasons for
- 5 exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the
- 6 appropriation made in this Act is necessary to serve the public
- 7 interest and to meet the need provided for by this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the
- 11 development of wildfire susceptibility and vulnerability maps
- 12 for the State pursuant to section 2 of this Act.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of
- 14 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act; provided that the moneys
- 15 appropriated by this Act shall not lapse at the end of the
- 16 fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is made; provided
- 17 further that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered on
- 18 June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
