A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOURISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 201B-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: The authority shall be headed by a policy-making 3 "(b) board of directors that shall consist of twelve members; 4 5 provided that: 6 (1) The members shall be appointed by the governor as provided in section 26-34, except as provided by this 7 8 section; The members shall include at least one representative 9 (2) 10 each from the city and county of Honolulu and the counties of Hawaii, Kauai, and Maui; 11 12 Three members shall be appointed by the governor from (3) 13 a list of three names submitted for each appointment by the president of the senate, and three members 14 15 shall be appointed by the governor from a list of 16 three names submitted for each appointment by the 17 speaker of the house of representatives; provided that



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1 if fewer than three names are submitted for each appointment, the governor may disregard the list; 2 At least six members shall have knowledge, experience, 3 (4) 4 and expertise in the area of accommodations, transportation, retail, entertainment, or attractions, 5 and at least one member appointed by the governor 6 7 shall have knowledge, experience, and expertise in the 8 area of Hawaiian cultural practices; provided that no 9 more than three members shall represent, be employed 10 by, or be under contract to any sector of the industry 11 represented on the board; 12 [(5) One member shall be the director of business, economic 13 development, and tourism, or the director's designee, 14 who shall be an ex officio voting member; 15 (6) (5) The governor shall make appointments to ensure 16 the fulfillment of all requirements of paragraphs (2) 17 and (4); provided that upon the occurrence of a 18 vacancy subject to paragraph (3), the governor shall 19 notify the president of the senate and the speaker of 20 the house of representatives of any unfulfilled 21 requirements pursuant to paragraphs (2) and (4), and



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the president of the senate or the speaker of the 1 house of representatives, as appropriate, shall submit 2 3 nominees who fulfill those requirements; and 4 [(7)] (6) No person who has served as a member of the board of directors of the Hawaii Visitors and Convention 5 Bureau shall be eligible to sit as a member of the 6 7 board of directors of the Hawaii tourism authority 8 until at least two years have expired between the 9 person's termination from service on the Hawaii 10 Visitors and Convention Bureau board and the person's 11 appointment to the authority's board of directors." 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 15
