### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3	designate	d and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§14</u>	1- Lease terms; invasive species. Notwithstanding
5	any law t	o the contrary, any lease that the department of
6	agriculture enters into, renews, or extends after the effective	
7	date of A	ct , Session Laws of Hawaii 2024, shall include
8	provisions stating that the department may:	
9	(1)	Enter the leased premises at any time to identity,
10		investigate, control, or eradicate invasive species;
11		<u>and</u>
12	(2)	Terminate the lease if the lessee refuses the
13		department entry or is found in violation of any
14		applicable law, rule, or order relating to the control
15		or eradication of invasive species."

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

# S.B. NO. 2560

### Report Title:

HDOA; Lease Terms; Invasive Species; Right of Entry; Termination

#### Description:

Provides that each lease that the Department of Agriculture enters into, renews, or extends after the effective date of this Act shall authorize the Department to: (1) Enter the leased premises at any time to identity, investigate, control, or eradicate invasive species; and (2) Terminate the lease if the lessee refuses the Department entry or is found in violation of any applicable law, rule, or order relating to the control or eradication of invasive species.

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
