A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BOTTLE FILLING STATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 107-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: "§107-27 Design of state buildings. (a) No later than 3 one year after the adoption of codes or standards pursuant to 4 5 section 107-24(c), the design of all state building construction shall be in compliance with the Hawaii state building codes, 6 except state building construction shall be allowed to be 7 8 exempted from: 9 County codes that have not adopted the Hawaii state building codes; 10 11 Any county code amendments that are inconsistent with (2) 12 the minimum performance objectives of the Hawaii state 13 building codes or the objectives enumerated in this 14 part; or 15 (3) Any county code amendments that are contrary to code 16 amendments adopted by another county.

1	(b) Exemptions shall include county ordinances allowing
2	the exercise of indigenous Hawaiian architecture adopted in
3	accordance with section 46-1.55.
4	(c) The State shall consider hurricane resistant criteria
5	when designing and constructing new public schools for the
6	capability of providing shelter refuge.
7	(d) Beginning July 1, 2023, where feasible and cost-
8	effective, the design of all new state building construction
9	shall:
10	(1) Maximize energy and water efficiency measures;
11	(2) Maximize energy generation potential; and
12	(3) Use building materials that reduce the carbon
13	footprint of the project.
14	(e) Beginning July 1, 2025, for any new state building
15	construction where a drinking fountain is required, there shall
16	also be a bottle filling station or a combined bottle filling
17	station and drinking fountain.
18	(f) As used in this section, "bottle filling station"
19	means a plumbing fixture connected to the potable water
20	distribution system and sanitary drainage system that is
21	designed and intended for filling personal use drinking water

- 1 bottles or containers at least ten inches in height. A "bottle
- 2 <u>filling station</u> may be separate from or integral to a drinking
- 3 fountain_and may incorporate a water filter and a cooling system
- 4 for chilling the drinking water."
- 5 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
