1 SECTION 1. Section 436B-19.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:

4 noncompliance with child support order [-]; unlawful fentanyl

(1) Authority has received certification from the child support enforcement agency pursuant to the terms of section 576D-13 that the licensee or applicant is not in compliance with an order of support or has failed to comply with a subpoena or warrant relating to a paternity or child support proceeding [-]; or

(2) Licensee or applicant is found to have been involved with unlawful fentanyl dealings through the business or profession.
