BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 2 or so 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for 4 prefabricated, modular, or kauhale-type housing for homeless 5 individuals and low-income households. 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the 7 governor for the purposes of this Act. 8 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of 9 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, 10 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the 11 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be 12 13 exceeded by \$ per cent. In addition, the or 14 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund 15 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further 16 exceeded by \$ or per cent. The combined total 17 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these
