A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that according to a
- 2 survey conducted by the department of Hawaiian home lands in
- 3 2022, more than twenty-eight thousand native Hawaiian
- 4 beneficiaries are currently on the homestead lease waiting list.
- 5 The legislature further finds that when beneficiaries on the
- 6 homestead lease waiting list pass away prior to receiving a
- 7 lease award, the beneficiary also loses the ability to have
- 8 their heirs succeed to a lease.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to allow the
- 10 department of Hawaiian home lands to grant posthumous lease
- 11 awards directly to qualified successors of elderly or terminally
- 12 ill beneficiaries who were on the waiting list; provided that
- 13 the successors file a claim for a lease award within four years
- 14 of the effective date of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) Any qualified successor of a beneficiary
- 16 who passed away while on the waiting list shall have four years

- 1 from the effective date of this Act to file a claim for a lease
- 2 award in place of the named deceased beneficiary.
- 3 (b) The department of Hawaiian home lands shall adopt
- 4 rules pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
- 5 administer this Act within one year of the effective date of
- 6 this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Description:

Authorizes qualified successors of beneficiaries on the waiting list who died before receiving a lease to file a claim for a lease award within four years of the effective date. Requires the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands to adopt rules by a certain date.
