A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS RULES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 371-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Any employer, employee, or other person who wilfully
- 4 violates any lawful rule of the department for which no penalty
- 5 is otherwise provided shall be fined [no more than $$500_{L}$] five
- 6 per cent of their yearly income, or imprisoned [no] not more
- 7 than six months, or both, for each offense.
- 8 (b) Any person who, after twenty-one days written notice
- 9 and the opportunity to be heard by the director, is found to
- 10 have violated any lawful rule of the department for which no
- 11 penalty is otherwise provided, shall be fined [no more than \$500
- 12 for each offense.] five per cent of their yearly income."
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 15 begun before its effective date.

- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

DLIR; Rules; Violation; Penalties

Description:

Modifies penalties for violations of the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations rules from a fixed fine to a fine proportional to the yearly income of the violator.

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
