BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 245-16.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 3 "(a) A person or entity commits the offense of unlawful 4 shipment of tobacco products if the person or entity: 5 Is engaged in the business of selling tobacco (1)6 products; and (2) 7 Knowingly ships or causes to be shipped any tobacco 8 products, except cigars, to a person or entity in this 9 State that is not a licensee under this chapter. 10 (b) This section shall not apply to the shipment of 11 [tobacco]: 12 (1) Large or little cigars; or 13 (2) Tobacco products if any of the following conditions 14 are met: 15 $[\frac{1}{1}]$ (A) The tobacco products are exempt from taxes as 16 provided by section 245-3(b); or

1	$[\frac{(2)}{(B)}]$ All applicable state taxes on the tobacco products
2	are paid in accordance with the requirements of
3	this chapter."
4	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
