A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LEGISLATORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$84- Legislators; state equipment; community
- 5 initiatives. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 6 chapter or any other law to the contrary, but subject to
- 7 subsections (b) and (c), a legislator may use state-owned or
- 8 state-operated equipment, including vehicles, computers, and
- 9 machines, for any bona fide community initiative.
- 10 (b) Any legislator who purports to use state-owned or
- 11 state-operated equipment for a bona fide community initiative
- 12 pursuant to subsection (a), but who actually uses the equipment
- 13 for any other purpose, shall be subject to the provisions of
- 14 this chapter, to the extent applicable.
- 15 (c) For the purposes of this section:
- "Bona fide community initiative" means any activity that:
- 17 (1) Is conducted within the legislator's district;



1	(2)	Responds to community needs, promotes civic
2		engagement, or fosters stronger connections among
3		community members; and
4	(3)	Is conducted by an entity that is not:
5		(A) A for-profit business entity;
6		(B) Managed or controlled by the legislator; or
7		(C) An employer of the legislator.
8	"Legislator" means any state senator or state	
9	representative who uses or attempts to use state-owned or	
10	state-operated equipment pursuant to this section."	
11	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
12	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were	
13	begun bef	ore its effective date.
14	SECT	ION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
