16	(b)	For purposes of this section, "luxury housing unit"
17	means a h	ousing unit, whether offered for sale or rent, that is

1	not affordable to a household earning per cent of the		
2	applicable area median income as determined by the United States		
3	Department of Housing and Urban Development.		
4	(c) If any part of this section conflicts with or is		
5	inconsistent with any other law or emergency proclamation, this		
6	section shall control."		
7	SECTION 2. This Act shall apply to any housing or		
8	infrastructure project developed pursuant to emergency		
9	proclamations issued by the governor and related to housing or		
10	affordable housing on July 17, 2023; September 15, 2023; or		
11	October 24, 2023; or any subsequent emergency proclamation		
12	issued by the governor relating to housing or affordable		
13	housing.		
14	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
15	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
