RELATING TO SCHOOL IMPACT FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that exempting housing
- 2 developed by the department of Hawaiian home lands from school
- 3 impact fees allows for more homes to be developed for
- 4 beneficiaries. The department of Hawaiian home lands currently
- 5 leases educational facilities for public schools, public charter
- 6 schools, early learning facilities, and other similar facilities
- 7 at minimal to no cost.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to make permanent the exemption
- 9 from school impact fees of housing developed by the department
- 10 of Hawaiian home lands.
- 11 SECTION 2. Act 197, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, is
- 12 amended by amending section 6 to read as follows:
- "SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval[+
- 14 provided that on July 1, 2024, section 1 of this Act shall be
- 15 repealed and section 302A 1603(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 16 shall be reenacted in the form in which it read on the day prior
- 17 to the effective date of this Actl."
