## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 377-4.7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) [No later than ten] Within ninety to one hundred
- 4 eighty days after [receiving a written request for collective
- 5 bargaining from an individual or labor organization [that] has
- 6 been newly organized or certified as a representative, the
- 7 parties shall meet and commence to bargain collectively and
- 8 shall make every reasonable effort to conclude and sign a
- 9 collective bargaining agreement."
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 11 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 12 begun before its effective date.
- 13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
