After the period 7 of revocation is complete, the person may apply for and, if the 8 person satisfies the examination requirements of section 9 286-108, the examiner of drivers may grant to the person a new 10 driver's license."

SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were begun before its effective date.
