- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-77, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§291C-77 Pedestrians soliciting rides, business, or
- 4 attention of motorist. (a) Except as otherwise provided by
- 5 county ordinance, no person shall stand in, walk along, or
- 6 otherwise occupy a portion of a highway for the purpose of
- 7 soliciting a ride, employment, business, or contributions from
- 8 the occupant of any vehicle.
- 9 (b) No person shall stand on or in proximity to a street
- 10 or highway for the purpose of soliciting the watching or
- 11 guarding of any vehicle while parked or about to be parked on a
- 12 street or highway.
- (c) No person shall engage in commercial activity,
- 14 advertising, soliciting, or any other activity that has the
- 15 effect of distracting or drawing the attention of drivers along
- 16 any street, roadway, or other public place within one hundred

- 1 feet of an intersection with the intent or purpose of engaging
- 2 with drivers."
