A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish a
- 2 three-year pilot program to examine signalized intersections.
- 3 SECTION 2. (a) There is established a three-year pilot
- 4 program within the department of transportation, in
- 5 collaboration with counties, to examine signalized
- 6 intersections:
- 7 (1) That are programmed to allow crosswalk and pedestrian
- 8 movement signs to commence four seconds before the
- green light is given to motor vehicle traffic when the
- walk button has been pressed; and
- 11 (2) That have automatic pedestrian movement signs and new
- 12 technologies.
- 13 (b) The department of transportation shall submit a report
- 14 of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 15 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 16 to the convening of the regular session of 2027.

- 1 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 2 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 4 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023,
- 5 and this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure
- 6 ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by
- 7 \$ or per cent. This current declaration takes
- 8 into account general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal
- 9 year 2024-2025 in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, and this Act
- 10 only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure
- 11 ceiling are that:
- 12 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
- serve the public interest; and
- 14 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
- addressed by this Act.
- 16 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$599,000 or so much
- 18 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to
- 19 establish a three-year pilot program within the department of
- 20 transportation.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
