A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that public safety is a
2 top priority for the State. Therefore, the legislature believes
3 that pedestrians crossing the street must be visible to drivers.
4 The legislature notes that other states have begun to prohibit
5 the parking of vehicles near crosswalks to improve pedestrian
6 visibility.

7 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to prohibit any
8 person from parking a vehicle or constructing or installing any
9 parking stall abutting the curb or edge of vehicle travel way
10 within twenty feet of a marked crosswalk on a public right of
11 way along a road or highway.

12 SECTION 2. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13 amended by adding a new section to part XI to be appropriately
14 designated and to read as follows:

15 "§291C- Parking near crosswalks; prohibited. (a) No
16 person shall park any vehicle or construct or install any
17 parking stall abutting the curb or edge of vehicle travel way

1 within twenty feet of a marked crosswalk on a public right of
2 way along a road or highway."

3 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
5 begun before its effective date.

6 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
