# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRINCE JONAH KUHIO KALANIANAOLE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes that Prince Jonah 2 Kuhio Kalanianaole led efforts to convince the United States 3 Congress to pass the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as 4 amended, under which the department of Hawaiian home lands was created. The legislature finds that requiring certain public 5 6 buildings near mass transit projects and on Hawaiian home lands 7 to display portraits of Prince Kuhio is an appropriate way to 8 honor the prince's legacy as the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act's 9 author.

10 The purpose of this Act is to require certain public
11 buildings near mass transit projects and on Hawaiian home lands
12 to display portraits of Prince Jonah Kuhio Kalanianaole.

13 SECTION 2. Chapter 27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 14 by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately designated 15 and to read as follows:
