A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FOOD SUPPLY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

| 1 | SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes that the number of |
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| 2 | animal slaughterhouses in the State, and their respective |
| 3 | capacities, are limited. Notably, only one slaughterhouse on |
| 4 | Oahu currently slaughters hogs. If any slaughterhouse ceases |
| 5 | operations, or ceases to slaughter any particular type of |
| 6 | animal, the effects on the State's food supply, market, |
| 7 | businesses, and consumers could be devastating. The legislature |
| 8 | therefore finds that the State should avert this potential |
| 9 | outcome and ensure a sustainable source of animal protein for |
| 10 | the State's consumers. |
| 11 | Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to: |
| 12 | (1) Require the department of business, economic |
| 13 | development, and tourism, in collaboration with the |
| 14 | agribusiness development corporation, to identify |
| 15 | sites throughout the State that are suitable for the |
| 16 | development of slaughterhouses; |

Requires the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to identify sites throughout the State that are suitable for the development of slaughterhouses. Requires the Agribusiness Development Corporation to plan, design, construct, and operate certain animal slaughterhouses throughout the State. Declares that the general fund expenditure ceiling is exceeded. Makes an appropriation. Takes effect 1/1/2060. (SD1)
