BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the adequate
staffing levels of the university of Hawaii college of tropical
agriculture and human resources is a matter of statewide concern
pursuant to article X, section 6, of the Hawaii State

6 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of 7 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, 8 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the 9 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, 10 will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal 11 year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by \$ per cent. , or 12 This current declaration takes into account general fund 13 appropriations authorized for fiscal year 2024-2025 on Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, and this Act only. The reasons for 14 15 exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that:
