# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII COLLEGE OF TROPICAL  
AGRICULTURE AND HUMAN RESOURCES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the adequate  
2 staffing levels of the university of Hawaii college of tropical  
3 agriculture and human resources is a matter of statewide concern  
4 pursuant to article X, section 6, of the Hawaii State  
5 Constitution.

6           SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of  
7 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,  
8 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the  
9 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023,  
10 will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal  
11 year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by \$                   , or                   per cent.  
12 This current declaration takes into account general fund  
13 appropriations authorized for fiscal year 2024-2025 on Act 164,  
14 Regular Session of 2023, and this Act only. The reasons for  
15 exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that:



1 (1) The appropriation made in this Act are necessary to  
2 serve the public interest; and

3 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs  
4 addressed by this Act.

5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general  
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for  
8 the college of tropical agriculture and human resources at the  
9 university of Hawaii at Manoa to establish five full-time  
10 equivalent (5.0 FTE) faculty positions; provided that the sums  
11 appropriated shall be expended as follows:

12 (1) \$ for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)  
13 extension specialist in water quality and conservation  
14 in the county of Maui;

15 (2) \$ for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)  
16 extension agent in livestock in Hilo, county of  
17 Hawaii;

18 (3) \$ for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)  
19 state extension specialist in livestock at the  
20 university of Hawaii at Manoa;



1           (4) \$                   for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)  
2                   extension agent in urban horticulture and food systems  
3                   in the city and county of Honolulu; and

4           (5) \$                   for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)  
5                   extension agent in health and community development in  
6                   the county of Maui.

7           The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of  
8 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

9           SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
