RELATING TO TRAFFIC SAFETY.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

exceptions. (a) Upon all roadways of sufficient width a

- (4) Upon a roadway designated and signposted one-waytraffic.
- 5 (b) Upon all roadways any vehicle proceeding at less than 6 the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under the 7 conditions then existing shall be driven in the right-hand lane then available for traffic, or as close as practicable to the 8 9 right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, except when overtaking 10 and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction or 11 when preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a 12 private road or driveway.
 - (c) Upon any roadway having four or more lanes for moving traffic and providing for two-way movement of traffic, no vehicle shall be driven to the left of the center line of the roadway, except when authorized by official traffic-control devices designating certain lanes to the left side of the center of the roadway for use by traffic not otherwise permitted to use [such] the lanes, or except as permitted under subsection (a) (2). This subsection shall not be construed to prohibit the

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- 1 crossing of the center line in making a left turn into or from
- 2 an alley, private road, or driveway.
- 3 (d) Upon any two-lane roadway providing for two-way
- 4 movement of traffic, any vehicle proceeding at ten miles per
- 5 hour or more below the posted speed limit where passing or
- 6 overtaking another vehicle is not possible or permitted, and a
- 7 line of five or more vehicles is following immediately behind,
- 8 shall move off the roadway at the nearest safe location where
- 9 sufficient space exists for trailing vehicles to overtake."

Report Title:

Two-Lane Highways; Traffic Safety; Slow-Moving Vehicles

Description:

Requires vehicles traveling ten miles per hour or more below the posted speed limit on a two-lane highway, behind which five vehicles are formed in a line, to pull over where possible to let the trailing vehicles proceed when passing is unsafe. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)

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
